Sub: Terms and Conditions of Loans- Reg.

Ref: 1. Circular No. 40/2013/Fin. Dated: 27.04.2013

2. G.O (P) No.157/2021/Fin dated: 26.11.2021

3. Circular No.44/2023/Fin dated:18.05.2023

Government have accorded sanction to introduce the module namely 'Loan Monitoring and Fund Management System' with effect from 10.12.2021 for the online management of loan sanctioning and disbursal as per G.O (P) No.157/2021/Fin dated 26.11.2021. As per the Circular

cited 1st above, it was directed to fix the terms and conditions of the loans and to incorporate the same in the Orders sanctioning the loans as stipulated in Kerala Financial Code. Later vide Circular No.44/2023/Fin dated 18.05.2023, a list of data fields (mainly related to terms and conditions) in the 'Loan' menu of e Ledger user in the software, which was made mandatory in the software from 25.05.2023, has been communicated by Finance Department and was requested to ensure that the orders sanctioning loans contain all such details. But some Departments are still issuing G.Os sanctioning loans without including mandatory details. However, the details are found to be furnished in the software . Inclusion of the above list of data in the sanction order is a legal requirement as per the Kerala Financial Code.

A provision for 'Loan Entry Backlog' will be available in the software from 12.06.2023 to enter all the mandatory fields in cases where the loans were sanctioned without including mandatory details in the Government Orders from 10.12.2021, that is, the date on which the 'Loan Monitoring and Fund Management System' was made operational. For this purpose, revised G.Os on such loans incorporating all the mandatory conditions have to be issued and based on it the officers concerned have to enter such details in the software using the 'Loan Entry Backlog' option. The backlog entry facility will be available for two months starting from 12/06/2023.

There is also an option available to enter data against the old loans that were sanctioned before the launch of the software. In this circumstance, it is requested to follow the above steps and the instructions in the earlier Circulars and to enter mandatory details in the loan sanction orders as well as in the software promptly.
